# Awards:

Medals will be provided for players finished in 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for each category.

## **Technical Regulation**

#### **Rules:**

Unless otherwise specified, the tournament will be held in accordance with the Regulation of the International Dart Federation (IDF).

#### **Requirements:**

All the properly registered players along with the payment of the registration fee and with the medical certificate of fitness for physical activities are allowed to take part in the competition.

#### **Categories:**

Men Open Women Open Team Open

Note: Organizers reserve the right to modify the number of categories on the basis of the number of registered players.

#### Game model

All games will be played as 501 flying start and double exit. Each game will be played with a referee from the group (the non-player).

#### Individual tournament

The tournament will be held according to the ABC Pool/ CUP system to even out differences in strength between the participating players .

a) The player who has won the most games is the winner.

b) The players are ranked in each pool according to points so that the player with the most **points** no. 1 and the next best is no. 2 etc.

**Note:** If two players are tied, the games they have played together decide the result. If the players are still tied, the player with the biggest difference between won and lost legs is the winner.

If the players are still tied then a decider has to be played.

The players have to play as 501 flying start with double exit using an equal amount of darts.

#### Playing time

Pool-games will be played to the best of 3 legs while finals will be played to the best of 5 legs.

#### Team tournament

#### Game model

Each team is made up of 4 players (men and/or women). Each match consists of 6 individual legs in the following order:

- □ Single 1
- □ Single 2
- Double 1
- □ Single 3
- □ Single 4
- $\square$  Double 2

All games will be played as 501 flying start and double exit.

Games will be played using referees provided by the teams on alternate basis.

## Tournament

The tournament will be held according to the ABC Pool/ CUP system to even out differences in strength between the participating teams.

The team which has won the most games is the winner.

The teams are ranked in each pool according to points so that the team with the most points is no.1 and the next best team is no.2 etc.

**Note:** If two teams are tied, the games they have played together decide the result. If the teams are still tied, the team with the biggest difference between won and lost matches, and with the biggest difference between won and lost legs, is the winner. If two teams are still tied then a decider has to be played.

Each team appoints a player to play 501 flying start with double exit using an equal number of darts.

#### **Playing time**

Pool-games will be played to the best of 3 legs while the finals will be played to the best of 5 legs.

#### **Results:**

Results will be published on the ECSG official website, in the "Darts" section, and on the noticeboard of the accreditation center set up in Tourism Palace.

#### Appeals:

All the appeals concerning the Championship must be lodged in written form with the judge within no longer than 30 minutes after the end of the match along with a deposit of €30 to be returned in case of admission.

#### **Final arrangements:**

Each participant travels and attends the event at own risk. Organizers provide first aid only.

It is compulsory to bring a copy of the individual insurance policy along all the time. Note: According to specific and unexpected needs, organizers reserve the right to modify and/or change the information in this schedule.
