Coordination:	Federazione Italiana Giuoco Squash (Figs)
Tournament Director:	Mr. Davide Babini
Venue:	Figs National Technical Centre Viale Forlimpopoli 5 – 47838 – Riccione
Date:	4th to 6th June 2015
Requirements:	each team must be registered at least 30 minutes before the game;
Awards:	players and teams on the first three positions will receive trophies, medals and diplomas;
	<u>Technical Background</u>
Rules:	the competion is in accordance with valid rules from WSF (World Squash Federation). A match is the best of 5 games, using PAR 11 scoring system;
Requirements for participation:	properly registered teams with the payment of entry fees;

Categories: Men's Open – 3 players (max 6 players per team);

Men's 40+ - 3 players (max 6 players per team);

Mixed Open – 2 men, 1 woman (max 4 men and 2 women); Mixed 40+ – 2 men, 1 woman (max 4 men and 2 women);

Format: the tournament will be held in three days; in the first two

days will be played the preliminary round and the

semifinals, in the third day the finals.

Tournament schedule is available in the ECSG official

website, in squash section;

Game System:

team consists of 3 players, each tie has 3 individual games

(M1, M2, M3)

A mixed team consist of 1 woman and 2 men, each tie has 3 individual games (W, M1, M2)

The daily playing order is drawn before the start of the tournament.

The team composition can be changed before starting a new match.

The team that wins two individual matches is the winner of the tie; if the score of the tie is 2/0, the third match will be played at the best of 3 games.

The players are required to be on court at the scheduled time for their match. If they don't show up within 10 minutes they automatically lose the match without any exceptions;

Classification criteria:

the tournament will be held under the k.o. system;

Balls:

the official tournament ball is Dunlop - double yellow dot;

Referees:

all players are expected to referee matches, as directed by the Tournament referee. Figs referees will be present during the whole tournament, to avoid any possible arguments. Semi finals and finals will be directed by Figs referees;

Results:

the results will be published on the official ESCG website, in the squash section, and on the tournament board, located at the venue;

Objection:

teams can protest against the results and the game itself no longer than 30 min after the end of their game, with a deposit of 20,00€ which will be, in case of rejection, forfeited. The tournament referee will go over any possible protests;

Final disposition:

each participant travels and attends at their own risk. The coordinator provides first aid only. We recommend having your insurance card on you all the time. The tournament director has the right to modify or change any information in the programme if necessary;
