





## Official Schedule – ARCHERY Individual and team tournaments

### **General Information**

**Supervisor:** Federazione Italiana Tiro con l'Arco (Italian Archery Federation)

**Tournament Director:** Ardingo Scarsella

**Location:** "Nicoletti" Sports center (Riccione)

**Date:** 4 - 5 June 2015

Time schedule: Matches will start at 9.00 and will end at 18.30

**Awards:** Medals will be provided to players finished in 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places for each category.

### Technical Regulation

### Rules:

Although it is not mentioned in this regulation, competition is played in accordance with the Regulation of World Archery concerning the target archery, set forth in Book 3, except for the short distance (50 m).

### **Requirements:**

All the properly registered players along with the payment of entry fees and the medical certificates of fitness for physical activities are allowed to take part in the competition.

### Categories:

Men "Open Class" Women "Open Class" No division based upon ability level is granted.

### Game model:

Competition shall consist of target archery match with Olympic bows.

The qualifying round shall consist of two series of 72 arrows shot from 50 m distance on the 122 cm target face. The official shots will be fired in the competition field.

- Both in eliminatory rounds and in finals, arrows will be shot from the same distance as in the qualifying round.
- Competition for Olympic bows will be played in accordance with Olympic rules: only individual competitions are granted while team competitions and set system are not granted;
- The eliminatory rounds will be set up in order to allow every participant to take part in one match at least.

### Team tournament:

Each team consists of 3 players. The team's score will be based upon the sum of each player's shots in the individual tournament. The team with the highest total score will win the tournament. In case of equality of score, the team of the player who has the highest score in the individual tournament will win the tournament. Mixed teams shall be allowed as well.

### Time schedule:

The morning session will start at 9 am while the afternoon session will start at 3 pm. The official shots will be fired in the competition field.

# Note: All players must show up at the scheduled time of the beginning of their matches.

### Attendance:

Players must be on the field of play 30 minutes before the match starts in order to facilitate the control of individual ID cards. Players who don't show up at the scheduled time of the beginning of the matches will lose the games.

### Equipment:

As far as equipment is concerned, players must refer to the Regulation of World Archery, Chapter 11.

Each participant shall provide for their own equipment.

Neither equipments renting nor equipments repairing are granted in the field of play.

### **Dress regulations:**

The official color of team uniform is white. Teams are allowed to wear the uniforms of their respective clubs or countries instead of wearing the white uniforms.

#### **Results:**

Results will be published on the ECSG official website, in the "Archery" section, and on the noticeboard of the accreditation center set up in Tourism Palace.

#### Appeals:

All appeals concerning the Championship must be lodged in written form with the judge within no longer than 30 minutes after the end of the match along with a deposit of  $\in$  30 which will be returned in case of admission.

#### Final arrangements:

Each participant travels and attends the event at own risk. Organizers provide first aid only. It is compulsory to bring a copy of individual insurance policy along all the time.
