





Official Schedule – BADMINTON Team Tournament

General Information

Organization:

Federazione Italiana Badminton (Italian Badminton Federation)

Location:

Palazzo dello Sport (Sport Palace)- Play Hall, Riccione

Date:

4-5-6 June 2015

Time schedule:

First matches will start at 9 am; last matches will end at 6.30 pm. No lunch breaks are planned.

Awards:

Medals will be provided for players finished in 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each category.

Technical Regulation

Rules:

Although it is not mentioned in this schedule, tournament will be held in accordance with the Regulations of Badminton World Federation (BWF).

Requirements:

All properly registered teams along with the payment of entry fees and the certificates of fitness for physical activities are allowed to take part in the competition.

Categories:

MIX OPEN (all age groups)
MIX MASTER (over 40 years)

Note: Organizers reserve the right to modify the number of categories on the basis of the number of registered players.

Game model:

MIX open class:

- Each team is made up of 3 players (max.6 players);
- Each team is made up of 1 woman and 2 men (max. 2 women and 4 men);
- Team composition can be changed before starting a new match;
- Each match consists of 4 games;
- Each game follows this order: Mixed Double, Men's Single, Women's single and Men's Double;

MIX master class:

- Each team is made up of 4 players (max. 8 players);
- Each Team is made up of 2 women and 2 men (max. 4 women and 4 men);
- Team composition can be changed before starting a new match;
- Each match consists of 4 games;
- Each game follows this order: 1st Mixed Double; 2nd Mixed Double, Men's Double and Women's Double.

Games

- The team which wins more games in a match is the winning team;
- In each round, team rankings are based upon scores. Team with the highest score
 will be the first team ranked; the second team with the highest score will be the
 second team ranked, etc.
- In case of equality of 2 teams, the game they played against each other decides the final ranking;
- If the teams are still equal, difference between the number of won and lost games, difference between the number of won and lost sets, and, lastly, difference of scores in won and lost sets will be taken into account;
- Games are played without referees. Players themselves will referee their games;
- Games are played with authorized shuttles only;
- Games are played at the best of 3 sets;
- Each set is played to 21 points. If the score reaches 20-all, the two point lead's rule up to 29-all is NOT applied. Matches will end when score reaches 21 points.

Attendance:

Teams must be at the playground 30 minutes before the match starts in order to facilitate the control of individual ID cards. For each match, the Team Manager shall submit the roster sheet with the names of the team players who take part in the match. Teams which do not show up at the scheduled time of the beginning of the matches will lose the games.

Note: All players must be at the playground at the scheduled time of the beginning of their matches.

Team Manager:

Each team must have its own Team Manager who must sign the team's Roster Sheet. The coach himself can be the Team Manager.

Results:

Results will be published on the ECSG official website, in the "Badminton" section, and on the noticeboard of the accreditation center set up in Tourism Palace.

Appeals:

All appeals concerning the Championship must be lodged in written form with the judge within no longer than 30 minutes after the end of the match along with a deposit of € 30 to be returned in case of admission.

Final arrangements:

Each participant travels and attends the event at own risk. Organizers provide first aid only. It is compulsory to bring a copy of individual insurance policy along all the time.
