Time schedule:

On 4 June 2014, at 9.00, schedule of all matches, planned for the 3-day competition, will be published.

Registration conditions will be notified in time, until one week before the beginning of the tournament.

Awards:

Medals will be provided for players finished in 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each category.

Technical Regulation

Rules:

Although it is not mentioned in this schedule, tournament will be played in accordance with the Regulation of Italian Tennis Federation (ITF) concerning Beach Tennis.

Requirements:

All properly registered teams along with the payment of the registration fee and with the medical certificates of fitness for physical activities are allowed to take part in the competition.

Categories:

Men's Double

Women's Double

Mixed Double
Men's Over 40 Double
Women's Over 40 Double

Note: Organizers reserve the right to modify number of categories on the basis of number of registered players.

Game model:

Participating teams will be divided into rounds. Each team will play against other teams of the same round. At the end, the best ranked teams in each round will play finals.

Playing time:

According to the number of registered players, only one match of 6 or 9 sets will be played.

If the match score is tied at 6-6 or at 8-8, 7 point tie-break system will be played to determine the winner in accordance with the Regulation of Beach Tennis.

The pre-match warm-up lasts 5 minutes.

Note: All players must be at the playground at the scheduled time of the beginning of their matches.

Attendance of teams:

Teams must be at the playground 30 minutes before the match starts in order to facilitate the control of individual ID cards.

Each player is responsible for the accuracy of personal data. If personal data and, in particular, certificate of fitness for physical activities are not accurate, penalty will be disqualification.

Teams which don't show up at the scheduled time of the beginning of their matches will lose the games.

Referees:

There will be Chair Umpire in finals only.

Results:

Results will be published on the ECSG official website.

Appeals:

All appeals concerning the Championship must be lodged in written form with the judge within no longer than 30 minutes after the end of the match, along with a deposit of € 30 to be returned in case of admission.

Final arrangements:

Each participant travels and attends the event at own risk. Organizers provide first aid only. It is compulsory to bring a copy of individual insurance policy along all the time.
