



Official Schedule – CYCLING

Time schedule:

Time trial: 4 June; starting time: 9.30

Road race: 5 June; starting time: 9.00

Awards:

Medals will be provided for all players finished in 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each category.

Technical Regulation

Rules:

Although it is not mentioned in this regulation, competition will be played in accordance with the rules of the Italian Cycling Federation and with the technical regulation of CSA In concerning cycling.

Requirements:

All properly registered players along with the payment of the registration fee and with the medical certificate of fitness for physical activities are allowed to take part in the competition.

Categories:

Participants will be divided into 5 age groups:

Category A: 18-30 years

Category B: 31-40 years

Category C: 41-50 years

Category D: 51-60 years

Category E: Over 60 years

Note: It is compulsory to wear helmets. Organizers reserve the right to modify the number of categories on the basis of the number of registered players.

Match schedule:

Competitions will be held in the Misano World Circuit and are made up of: **Time trial** and **Road race**, both as road cycling specialities. There will be a special "combined" ranking and respective awards for those who will take part in both competitions. The Competition Director reserves the right to unify more categories into a single competition without affecting the arriving order and awards for the defined categories.

Anyway, women and men will compete into separate competitions.

The "ECSG 2015" title can be given only if, in each category, at least 3 participants will line up at the beginning of the race. Otherwise, they will compete for the title in the superior category.

All participants must respect the rules set up from the Competition Director and any other change in this schedule which will be anyway notified before the beginning of the event.

Rules of Time trial to be held on 4 June 2015

Competition consists of 2 laps around the Misano World Circuit, 8,452 m on the whole.

The first participant will start at 9.30, then, the following participants will start 1 minute after the previous participant's starting time.

Even if a participant starts later than the starting time, time starts running from the scheduled starting time. Each participant is not allowed to ride in the wake of the other participants' vehicles. Participants shall ride at least 25 m away from the others. It is allowed to overtake other participants on the left without being an obstacle. Those who don't respect this rule will be expelled from the arriving order.

Rules of Road race to be held on 5 June 2015

Competition consists of 12 laps around the Misano World Circuit, 50,712 Km on the whole, for men, and 10 laps around the circuit, 42,260 Km on the whole, for women.

Starting time to be defined

We remind that, according to the number of participants, the Competition Director reserves the right to unify categories without affecting the arriving order and awards for the defined categories. The lapped riders will have to stop and they will be ranked according to the previous time they have crossed the finishing line.

Rules of the Special Combined Ranking

There will be a special "combined" ranking for those players ranked in both competitions (time trial and road race) which will take into account the ranking of both competitions and will add the score gained in both specialities. The assigned score is as follows: the ranked no.1 gains 100 points; the following riders' score is decreased by 1 point along in the

ranking order (if there are more than 100 ranked players, the score will be based on the number of the ranked participants).

Note: All players must show up at the scheduled time of the beginning of their match.

Results:

Results will be published on the ECSG official website, in the “Cycling” section, and on the noticeboard of the accreditation center set up in Tourism Palace.

Appeals:

All appeals concerning the Championship must be lodged in written form with the judge within no longer than 30 minutes after the end of the match, along with a deposit of €30 which will be returned in case of admission.

Final arrangements:

Each participant travels and attends the Games at own risk. Organizers provide first aid only. It is compulsory to bring a copy of the individual insurance policy along all the time.

Note: According to specific and unexpected needs, organizers reserve the right to modify and/or change the information in this schedule.
