Location:

Via dell'Artigianato (2 playgrounds), Riccione San Lorenzo (2 playgrounds x 2), Riccione Spontricciolo (2 playgrounds), Riccione Via Arezzo (2 playgrounds), Riccione Via Brunate (2 playgrounds), Riccione Campo Asar (2 playgrounds), Riccione

Date: 4- 5- 6 June 2015

Time schedule:

Matches will start at 9.00 and will end at 18.30. Time schedule will be later defined according to the teams which will take part in the competition.

Awards:

Medals will be provided for players finished in 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each category.

Technical Regulation

Pitch dimensions:

Pitch dimensions are 50 m x 30 m; goal dimension is 6 m x 2 m.

Team compositions:

Teams are made up of a maximum of 14 players: 7 first-string players (at least 4) and 7 substitutes.

Categories:

Men "Open Class" Men "Senior Class" (40+) Women "Open Class"

Substitution of players:

The number of substitutions is unlimited; the substituted player may take further part in the match. Substitutions are allowed at any time, in the team's substitution zone. The substitute only enters the pitch after the player being replaced has left. The goalkeeper shall be substituted only during a stoppage of play and with referee's permission.

Throw-in:

To restart playing with the throw-in, both hands must be used.

Offside:

The offside rule is not applied.

Sanctions:

The yellow card means suspension for 5 minutes; 2 yellow cards mean suspension to the end of the match and the suspension for one match. Red card means at least suspension for one match.

Although it is not mentioned in this regulation, the competition will be played in accordance with the Regulation of UEFA.

Requirements:

All members of properly registered teams along with the payment of the registration fee and with the medical certificate of fitness for physical activities are allowed to take part in the competition.

Note: Organizers reserve the right to modify the number of categories on the basis of the number of registered players.

Game model

According to the number of participants, teams will be divided into preliminary rounds which will define the ranking. Teams which have finished in 1st and 2nd places in every round will play the final "A" (for the best teams); teams which have finished in 3rd and 4th places will play the final "B" (Consolation final).

Playing time:

The game shall consist of 2 periods of 20 minutes and intervals of 5 minutes between the first and the second period. Each team is entitled to a one-minute time-out in each period. Either the team's Captain or the Team Manager must request the referee for a time-out. The pre-match warm-up lasts 10 minutes.

Note: All the players must be at the playground at the scheduled time of the beginning of their match.

Attendance

Teams must be at the playground 15 minutes before the match starts in order to facilitate the control of individual ID cards. Those who don't have their ID cards are not allowed to take part in the match. For each match, the Team Manager shall submit the Roster Sheet with the names of the team players who take part in the match. Teams which don't show up at the scheduled time of the beginning of the match will lose the match.

Team Manager:

Each team must have its own Team Manager who must sign the team's Roster Sheet. The coach himself can be the Team Manager.

Referees:

In the preliminary round, organizers will provide 1 referee and 1 Commissioner of field; in the knockout rounds, organizers will provide 1 referee and 2 assistant referees.

Results:

Results will be published on the ECSG official website, in the "Football" section, and on the noticeboard of the accreditation center set up in Tourism Palace.

Appeals:

All appeals concerning the Championship must be lodged in written form with the Commissioner of field within no longer than 15 minutes after the end of the match, along with a deposit of \in 30 to be returned in case of admission.

Final arrangements:

Each participant travels and attends the event at own risk. Organizers provide first aid and defibrillators. It is compulsory to bring a copy of individual insurance policy along all the time.

Note: According to specific and unexpected needs, organizers reserve the right to modify and/or change the information in this schedule.
