Date:

4- 5 June 2015

Time schedule:

First departure is at 9.00; last departure is at 13.00.

Awards:

Medals will be provided for players finished in 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. Awards will be provided for the first three ranked teams in individual net category, for players finished in the first three places in every individual net category and for players (both men and women) finished in the first place in overall gross category.

Technical Regulation

Rules:

Although it is not mentioned in this regulation, competition is played in accordance with the R&A Rules Limited (in the Italian version by Italian Golf Federation) and with the rules of the hosting club.

Golf carts:

Golf carts are prohibited and their possible use is based on the decision of Tournament Director and on production of specific medical certificate, while carts last. Players renting

golf carts will pay on their own. Those who will infringe this rule will be disqualified from the tournament.

Requirements:

Players are responsible for their Exact hcp as indicated at the time of registration. The payment of the entry fee confirms registration to this competition.

Registered players must show up at the receptions of the golf clubs which host the scheduled event for accreditation, submitting their ECSG membership cards and their respective Golf National Federation cards which must be valid at least 30 minutes before their tee time.

Categories:

As far as the individual category competition is concerned, individual categories are the following:

Group A hcp 0-14

Group B hcp 15 - 25

Group C hcp 26 – 36

Note: Organizers reserve the right to modify the number of categories on the basis of the numbers of registered players.

Rules of team competition:

Teams are made up of 3 players who take part in the individual competition. Teams can include only men, only women or both of them, from the same club as indicated at the time of registration.

Attendance:

Players must be at the playground 30 minutes before the beginning of their matches in order to facilitate the control of individual ID cards. If players don't show up at the scheduled time of the beginning of the matches they will be disqualified.

Game model:

The starting tee is red for women and blue for men.

Tournament is NOT played in accordance with hcp and it is based on stableford system.

Tournament is played over 36-hole distance (9+9 / 9+9).

Note: Measuring equipment is allowed if it is in accordance with the rules of the hosting golf club.

Individual competition ranking:

In each hcp category, the player with the highest stableford score, based on the sum of the individual scores got during the 2-day competition, is the winner. The overall gross winner is the player who gets the lowest number of strokes based upon the sum of the strokes taken over the 2-day competition. In case of equality of score, scoring criteria are the following:

- Best stroke taken.
- The last 9 holes of the round (or, in case of a tie, the best 9 holes played during the 2-day competition).
- The last 6 or 3 holes, or the last one, of the last day of competition.
- Day and time of registration.

Team competition ranking:

Team's score is based on the sum of the scores got by single players in the net-category, who play in the same team, over the 2-day competition.

The team with the highest score is the winner.

In case of equality of score, scoring criteria are the following:

- Best individual score.
- Comparison of the scores according to the above-mentioned criteria.

Artificial devices (Riviera Golf Rule 14-3 Appendix IV):

On this course, a player can get information on distances through LASER or GPS devices which measure distance only.

During a round, if players use devices to measure distances that are designed to measure other conditions which might assist players in their games (e.g: slope, wind, temperature, etc.), it would be a breach of Rule 14-3, the penalty for which is **disqualification**, even if the additional information is not used.

Using smartphones, tablets and PDAs which have application to measure distances is allowed only if:

- their use satisfies all the restrictions of Rules and Appendix IV;
- the mentioned application is not capable of measuring conditions or providing information other than distance (e.g. wind, temperature or club recommendation);
- the device doesn't contain other applications or features which might assist players in their games (e.g. anemometer, thermometer or club recommendation)

Results:

Results will be published on the ECSG official website, in the "Golf" section, and on the notice board of the accreditation center set up in Tourism Palace.

Appeals:

All appeals concerning the competitions must be lodged in written form with the judge within no longer than 30 minutes after the end of the match, along with a deposit of € 30 to be returned in case of admission.

Final arrangements:

Each participant travels and attends the event at own risk. Organizers provide first aid only. It is compulsory to bring a copy of individual policy along all the time.
