





Official Schedule – HANDBALL Team tournament

General Information

Supervisor: Federazione Italiana Giuoco Handball - Pallamano (Italian Handball Federation)

Tournament Director: Marco Tosi Brandi

Location: Indoor stadium, Rimini Fair of Rimini, Rimini

Date: 4- 5- 6 June 2015

Time schedule: From 9.00 to 18.30. No lunch breaks are planned.

Awards: Medals will be provided for players finished in 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each category.

Technical Regulation

Rules:

Although it is not mentioned in this regulation, competition will be played in accordance with the rules of the International Handball Federation (IHF).

Requirements:

All properly registered players along with the payment of the registration fee and with the medical certificate of fitness for physical activities are allowed to take part in the competition.

Categories:

Men Open Men Over 40 years Women Open Women Over 40 years

Note: Organizers reserve the right to change the number of categories in

Game model:

The participating teams will be divided into groups where each team plays against the other teams of the same group. At the end, the best ranked teams of each group will play the finals.

Each team will play against the other teams according to the tournament's groups. The key to play up to the finals is as follows:

1) Higher number of points gained in the group;

- 2) Higher number of points gained from mutual matches against other teams;
- 3) Higher difference in goals from mutual matches against other teams;
- 4) Higher number of goals from mutual matches against other teams;
- 5) Higher difference in goals from all matches in the group;
- 6) Higher number of goals from all matches in the group;

7) Draw

After the preliminary round, in the qualification matches, in case of draw, 7 m throws (series of 3 throws) will immediately follow.

Each player is allowed to play in one team only. Only 16 players are allowed to take part in each match. The list of the players must be submitted to the referees at least 10 min before the match.

Special arrangements:

NO Team Time Out;

NO Stop of the clock in case of a 7 m throw;

NO Stop in case of 2 min. suspension.

The team defined as "guest team"- Team B- shall change its shirts in case of same colour or not clearly different colours.

Playing time:

Duration of the match according to categories:

Men and Women: 2 x 15 min. with 1 minute long break; no side exchanges.

Men Over 40 years (40+): 1 x 25 min.

Matches will start in accordance with the schedule list for each hall. The waiting time lasts 5 minutes. However, if one team doesn't show up or it isn't ready to begin the match, the result of the match will be set 5-0 in favour of the present team.

Note: All players must be on the play of field at the scheduled time of the beginning of their match.

Attendance:

Teams must show up 30 minutes before the beginning of their match in order to facilitate the control of ID card. For each match, the Team Manager shall submit the Roster Sheet including the names of participants in the match.

Team Manager:

Each team must have its own Manager Team who must sign the Roster Sheet. The coach himself can be the Team Manager.

Referees:

There will be Federation's referee in all the matches.

Results:

Results will be published on the ECSG official website, in the "Handball" section, and on the noticeboard of the accreditation center set up in Tourism Palace.

Appeals:

The Competition Manager reserves the right to exclude the team that leaves the field of play during the match; the team's result will be cancelled. All the appeals concerning the Championship must be lodged in written form with the judge within no longer than 30 minutes after the end of the match along with a deposit of \in 30 which will be returned in case of admission.

Final arrangements:

Each participant travels and attends the Games at own risk. Organizers provide first aid only. It is compulsory to bring a copy of the individual insurance policy along all the time.
