Awards:

Medals will be provided for players finished in 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each category.

Technical Regulation

Rules:

Players only are entitled to have access to the courses. Exceptions to this rule are decided by people in charge.

Equipment must be returned intact at the end of the lanes. In case of loss and damage, the Direction reserve the right to claim for damages.

It is strictly forbidden:

- Going from one lane to another one.
- Lifting the putter above the waist and hitting the ball with too energy.
- Walking on the grass and/or throwing any kind of garbage.
- Using putters to hit any kind of objects that are not the ball.

Although it is not mentioned in this regulation, competition will be held in accordance with the Regulation of World Minigolf Sport Federation (WMF).

Requirements:

All properly registered members along with the payment of the registration fee and with the medical certificate of fitness for physical activities are allowed to take part in the competition.

Categories: Men "Open Class" Women "Open Class"

Game model

The tournament lasts 2 days. All participants will play 6 rounds in accordance with WMF. The Tournament Director will divide players into groups of three. Groups division will be published on the event's official website, in "Minigolf" section, and it will be notified at the arrival of participants.

The player with the lowest number of overall strokes of all rounds will be the winner. In case of equality of score, there will be a tie-break.

Team tournament:

Each team is made up of 3 players from one company. The team's score will depend on the sum of the strokes of the players in the individual tournament. The team with the lowest number of overall strokes will be the winner. In case of a tie, the team of the player with the lowest number of strokes will be the winner. Teams can be mixed as well.

System of play:

- Each player will be provided with clubs and balls to be returned at the end of the match. Players have the possibility to use their own clubs.
- Each group will be provided with score-cards which must include the players' names and the number of strokes taken by each player to hit the ball into the hole.
- Players play one by one.
- Each player has a maximum of six strokes for every lane.
- After six strokes, players stop playing and write down"7" in the proper space on the score-cards. Then, they restart playing in the following lane (6 strokes+1 penalty for the missing lane).
- If a ball leaves the playing area, it is placed up to 10 cm from the point where it left the playing area. 1 penalty stroke is added. (e.g. if a ball leaves the playing area when the second stroke is taken, it is placed at the point where it left the playing area and the third stroke becomes the fourth stroke because of the 1 penalty stroke added).
- If a ball is shot into water, 2 penalty points are added
- For each hole, there is an ideal number of strokes which define the level of difficulty of the hole itself. Technically speaking, this is called PAR.
- The aim of this game is to end the lane with the lowest number of strokes.

All players must be at the playground at the scheduled time of the beginning of their matches. If they don't show up within any longer than 10 minutes, they will lose the match with no exceptions.

Referees:

Players themselves have to referee their matches.

Results:

Results will be published on the ECSG official website, in "Minigolf" section, and on the noticeboard of Circolo Indiana Golf.

Appeals:

All appeals concerning the Championship must be lodged in written form with the Judge within no longer than 30 minutes after the end of the matches, along with a deposit of \in 30 which will be returned in case of admission.

Final arrangements:

Each participant travels and attends the event at own risk. Organizers provide first aid only It is compulsory to bring the insurance policy along all the time.
