# **General Information**

#### Awards:

Medals will be provided for players finished in 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in each category.

# Technical Regulation

#### Rules:

Although it is not mentioned in this regulation, competition will be played in accordance with the rules of International Shooting Federation (ISSF).

# Requirements:

All properly registered players, along with the payment of the registration fee and with the medical certificate of fitness for physical activities, are allowed to take part in the competition.

# Categories for Individual shooting:

Men: 60 shots (10m air rifle – 10m air pistol)

Women: 40 shots (10m air rifle – 10m air pistol)

It will be possible to hold a 10m air rifle competition with support for men and women over 40 years (40+).

#### **Disciplines:**

Compressed air pistol (10m air pistol)

Compressed air rifle (10m air rifle)

# **Categories for Team shooting:**

Each team shall be made up of 3 markspeople for each discipline, without regard to gender, whose names shall be indicated before the beginning of the matches. A woman who participates in men's team will fire 60 shots for the score of the team ranking, while the first 40 shots will be included for the individual ranking.

Note: Organizers reserve the right to modify the number of categories on the basis of the number of registered players.

#### Game model:

Matches will be held with paper targets.

In the qualifying matches (60 shots for men and 40 shots for women), the score without decimals will be calculated. Matches will be held according to the one shot for each target format.

Groups will be chosen by lot 15 days before the beginning of the competition. The first 8 markspeople of each discipline (Men and Women 10m air pistol; Men and Women 10m air rifle) will take part in finals.

Finals will be played in accordance with the new regulation of the ISSF.

The first 8 markspeople ranked will start finals with 0 points. The finals format is as follows: it consists of two series of 3 shots followed by series of 2 shots. After each series of 2 shots, the marksperson with the lowest score will be eliminated. It continues until there is only the winner.

In the finals, the score with decimals will be calculated through specific electronic devices. As far as the team ranking is concerned, the score got in the qualifying competition will be taken into account.

Note: It is necessary that each participant brings their own support in order to take part in the competition with a support. All players must be on the field of play at the scheduled time of the beginning of their matches.

#### Check of weapons and clothes:

It will take place before the beginning of matches.

# Results:

Results will be published on the ECSG official website, in the "Shooting" section, and on the noticeboard of the accreditation center set up in Tourism Palace.

# Appeals:

All appeals concerning the Championship must be lodged in written form with the judge within no longer than 30 minutes after the end of the match, along with a deposit of € 30 which will be returned in case of admission.

#### Final arrangements:

Each participant travels and attends the Games at own risk. Organizers provide first aid only. It is compulsory to bring a copy of the individual insurance policy along all the time.
