Matches; final for the 1st and the 3rd places in the following categories: Mixed Open, Mixed Over 40 years; final for women categories.

Saturday, 6 June, from 10:00 to 14:00

Final for the 1st and 3rd places in the following categories: Men Open and Men Over 40 years.

Awards:

Medals will be provided for players finished in 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each category.

Technical Regulation

Rules:

Although it is not mentioned in this regulation, competition will be played in accordance with the rules of the International Table Tennis Federation.

Requirements:

All properly registered players along with the payment of the registration fee and with the medical certificate of fitness for physical activities are allowed to take part in the competition.

Categories: Men and Women

Men Open

Men Over 40 years (40+)

Women Open

Women Over 40 years (40+)

Mixed Open

Mixed Over 40 years (40+)

Note: Organizers reserve the right to modify the number of categories on the basis of the number of registered players.

Game model:

A team consists of between 2 (minimum) and 4 players (maximum). Each team will play 3 matches in the following order:

Man

- · Men's double
- Men's single 1
- Men's single 2

Women

- Women's double
- Women's single 1
- · Women's single 2

Mixed

- · Mixed double
- · Women's single
- Men's single

Playing format:

Matches will be played in accordance, first, with the group system and, then, with the knockout format. The teams ranked no.1 and 2 will be included in the main scoreboard, while the other teams will be included in the scoreboard for the rematches. The winning team gets 2 points, the losing team gets 1 point, and the retired team gets 0 point. All matches are played at the best of 5 sets. Each set is played up to 11 points.

Note: All players must show up at the scheduled time of the beginning of their match. The predominant colour of their T-shirts must be different from the ball's colour.

Criteria for ranking in the groups

- 1. points
- 2. set ratio of won/lost sets

3. point ratio of won/lost points

Attendance:

Teams must show up 30 minutes before the beginning of their match in order to facilitate the control of individual ID cards.

Each player is responsible for the accuracy of personal data. If personal data are not accurate, penalty will be disqualification.

If players won't show up at the scheduled time of the beginning of their match, their team will lose the match.

Referees:

Matches will be played with a referee. Players themselves will have to referee their matches.

Results:

Results will be published on the ECSG official website, in the "Table Tennis" section, and on the noticeboard of the accreditation center set up in Tourism Palace.

Appeals:

All appeals concerning the Championship must be lodged in written form with the judge within no longer than 30 minutes after the end of the match along with a deposit of €30 which will be returned in case of admission.

Final arrangements:

Each participant travels and attends the event at own risk. Organizers provide first aid only. It is compulsory to bring a copy of the individual insurance policy along all the time.
