# 3. About the games

Wednesday:

### 3.1 About accreditations

We want your team coordinators to check in at the Meeting Center, only by showing a valid ID-card they will receive the team packages. A few extra people are allowed in to help your team coordinator carry the packages. Please limit the number of people so we can maintain overview. Your team captain will receive the goodiebags, team accreditations, dinner tickets, ... Team packages can only be picked up at Wednesday from 9 a.m. until 9 p.m. at the Meeting Center (Bijloke, Godshuizenlaan 2, 9000 Ghent) there is only limited parking available at the Meeting Center. Any team changes (fe. due to last minute injuries) can 'only) be processed on that day at the Meeting Center. Please be aware payments on Wednesday are not possible, if your team hasn't paied by Wednesday your team will not be allowed to participate!

### 3.2 General

Your team can make use of the free shuttle from the railway station to the Meeting Center. From this day on we advise you to wear your accreditation with you at all times, this is your entrance ticket for the Meeting Center, sports venues, public transport, dinner, ... If you lose it or don't have it with you you will need to buy day passes and new food vouchers. In front of the Meeting Center taxi's will be waiting to bring you to your hotel (fee not included). All necessary information, plans, etc. will be in your goodiebag. We expect you back at the Meeting Center at p.m. for dinner and an astonishing opening Bringing along extra people who don't participate in the games? Press is offered free entrance if they show a valid press card, visitors can buy entrance tickets and food tickets at the spot.

# Thursday, Friday:

During these sporty days you can contact us in the Meeting Center from 4 p.m. until 9 p.m. or you can come in to consult playing schedules, results, tourist information, transport information, ... We are at your disposal via sms, mail, phone and even on whatsapp from 9 a.m. until 9 p.m. . 








### 4. About Ghent



Although weather in Belgium is hard to predict we already took a sneak peek which is quite promising! For the sensitive-skinned amongst you, some sunscreen and sunglasses could come in handy. Public intoxication, glass bottles and littering are forbidden in public places so keep this in mind if you are exploring the city center. Ghent is also (one of) the biggest student cities in Belgium and final exams are finished end of June so you might bump in to some overly crowded pubs (especially in "the Overpoort"; you might want to avoid this party street if you don't like big crowds). Also the Blaarmeersen, where a lot of sports will take place, is a well-known hangout spot during summer, it could be crowdy here as well. Currency is € and compared to other European countries we are nor expensive, nor very cheap. Fe. €2 for a beer is a good deal (I want to bet some Scandinavian people are getting a smile on their face now ②). Country dial code for Belgium is (00)32.

# 5. Transportation

Transportation tips:

- #1 : Make sure to look for your hotel address and check out the connection between your hotel and the meeting center + your hotel and your sports venue. Public transportation is free with your accreditation but will not be available around the clock. Participants for the golf and bowling can make use of our own (free) shuttles. If you want to make use of the shuttle, please indicate it via <a href="this link">this link</a>. (Only available for golf and bowling since these sports are located outside Ghent and hard to reach by public transport).
- #2: Avoid cars and busses in the city center since you will get fined as you enter the city center as a non-resident. Cameras are registering your license plate in certain areas and a ticket will follow. If you don't have another option, be aware of the signs, they show you where you are allowed to drive and where not. Besides, finding parking spots will be a challenge! Golden rule: make use of public transport whenever you can.















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#3: Is your hotel close to the Meeting Center and your sports venue? Best possible alternative for you is a bike! Reservation in advance is obligatory via this link.

- 1. Rent your bike.
- 2. Pay in advance.
- 3. Receive your bike the 21st at the Meeting Center and return it the 24th.
- #4: Don't follow the crowd, we have mentioned the best suited bus connection to the sports venues in the bulletins but this doesn't mean there is no alternative. Some sports venues are served by 6 different busses! However, if everybody takes the one we mentioned it will be overcrowded. Check the website or the city plan and use alternatives to save time and comfort.
- #5 : Keep your eyes open for the plates below, they will show you directions from every bus stop to your sports venue. Example, volleyball and swimming to the left, beachvolleyball and long distance swimming to the right (sorry for the tricky example, check the website to make sure which one is yours).





#6: Using trains? Then remember your accreditation pass is **not valid here** and you will need to pay for your trainride. Make sure to book in advance to reduce the price and guarantee your spot (only for groups).
