General provisions

Venue:	Union-Sandeman – Kantienberg 5, 9000 Gent
Date:	22/06/2017 – 23/06/2017
Presentation:	Presentation of players is required the latest 30 minutes before the start of their first game.
Awards:	The 3 best teams will receive medals and diplomas.

Technical provisions

Rules:	The competition is in accordance with the 2007 Laws of the World Bridge Federation and the regulations mentioned in this document.
	The Tournament Director will preshuffle the deals randomly. Composition of the round robins will be based per country, such that teams of the same country meet early on.
Conditions of participa	ation: Properly registred teams in the term, including payment of invoices.
Class division:	Tournament is played in pairs. There are no different class divisions.
Game model:	A Howell type method will be used, such that every team meets every other team exactly once. Each session includes at least 18-20 deals.
System policy:	EBL Systems Policy version July 2015. HUM systems and Brown Sticker conventions are prohibited (Category 3). Each pair is obliged to complete the event's official system card in legible English.
Alerting:	Any call which has a special or artifical meaning or whose meaning may not be understood by the opponents, is an alertable call, which must be brought to the immediate attention of the opponents with the use of the alert card.

Results:	Results will be hung out on the sports venue. Also each evening all results will be published in the Meeting Center.
Appeals:	Appeals have to be handed in at the latest 10 minutes after the end of the segment of play with the assistance and to the hands of the TD. Appeals have to be submitted in writing with the use of an official appeal form together with a deposit of 20 EUR. The deposit will be refunded if the appellant's case is judged to have merit, even if rejected. Appeals are to be resolved by a comittee consisting of the event's Tournament Director and an ECSG representative as quickly as tournament operation permits.
Special arrangements:	Each participant travels and attends at his own risk. The organiser provides first aid only. It is recommended to carry your insurance card with you at all time.
