

A TERRITORY IN ACTION



AN ECOLOGICALLY RESPONSIBLE EVENT

Like any human activity, the organization of a major sporting event can have negative effects on the environment that are essential to reduce or even reverse.

The Organizing Committee of the 24th European Company Sport Games is doing its utmost to offer a more environmentally friendly and inclusive event.


Indeed, sports events, and more particularly major international sports events, have a duty to set an example. They also serve to sustainably shape the behavior and habits of spectators, athletes and partners, thus contributing to the evolution of social norms and reducing the environmental footprint of participants.

A comprehensive action plan is in place to promote sustainable development. Within this plan, four main axes have been established:

- **Reduce the carbon footprint by organizing a 100% "public transport" event.**
- **Limiting the production of garbage but also enhancing the recycling of waste generated and ensuring effective monitoring of waste recovery and sorting channels.**
- **Promote a responsible purchasing policy by favoring local and committed actors.**
- **Involve the event on a societal level by organizing an inclusive event (people with disabilities, gender diversity, young people seeking employment, etc.).**

To mark its commitment, the Organizing Committee is a signatory of the charter of fifteen eco-responsible commitments of the Ministry of Sports. Created at the initiative of several major international sporting events, in collaboration with WWF, this charter has already enabled more than 350 international or national events to move towards greater eco-responsibility.

This dynamic is also being pursued within the framework of a European project led by the European Association of Sports Employers (EASE), which aims to build a social charter for sports events. The FFSE and the EFCS are partners in this project alongside the 2023 Rugby World Cup Organizing Committee and the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games Organizing Committee.

SPORTING PROGRAM

THE 24TH EDITION OF THE EUROPEAN COMPANY SPORT GAMES WILL FEATURE A TOTAL OF 37 SPORTS IN COMPETITION, 4 OF WHICH WILL HAVE A SPECIFIC RANKING FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES. ALSO, FOR THE VERY FIRST TIME, AROUND TEN LEISURE AND DISCOVERY ACTIVITIES ARE ON THE PROGRAM OF THESE GAMES. EACH PARTICIPANT HAS THE OPPORTUNITY TO COMPETE FOR AT LEAST TWO DAYS. IT IS POSSIBLE TO REGISTER FOR A SINGLE DISCIPLINE IN COMPETITION OR FOR THE "LEISURE AND DISCOVERY" PROGRAM. THE OFF-STAGE RACE ON SATURDAY IS OPEN TO ALL PARTICIPANTS. THE RULES AND PROGRAMS WILL BE PUBLISHED ON THE EVENT'S WEBSITE.

IF THE NUMBER OF REGISTRATIONS IS NOT SUFFICIENT FOR A DISCIPLINE, THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE MAY DECIDE TO CANCEL IT OR TO GROUP CERTAIN AGE CATEGORIES. THE HOLDING OF THE EVENTS WILL BE MADE OFFICIAL ACCORDING TO THE NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS.

The 24th European Company Sport Games will of course offer the most popular disciplines of the last editions but also new ones such as triathlon or local disciplines to discover such as Basque pelota.

As tradition requires, the sports program will end on Saturday afternoon with a 5 or 10 km off-stage race in which you can all participate.

GRAND OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONIES

On Wednesday, 14th June 2023, in the early evening, it will be time to officially start this 24th edition of the European Company Sport Games. The gathering of the thousands of participants will take place right next to HANGAR 14 from where the parade will start along the quays of the Garonne River for one kilometer to reach the famous "Place Des Quinconces".

Lined with trees, this square occupies a vast site of **12 hectares in the center of the city, which makes it the largest square in Europe.** It is decorated on the east side by two rostral columns and on the west side by the Monument to the Girondins. Numerous events take place there all year long: **River Festival, Wine Festival, Antiques Fair, Pleasure Fair, concerts, circuses, sports events...**

The Place des Quinconces hosts all the biggest festive gatherings of the city, and it is quite naturally that the **opening ceremony show will be organized there.**





GOING OUT IN BORDEAUX AND AROUND BORDEAUX



Apart from the 6 selected golf courses, all the sports sites of the 24th European Company Sports Games are located within a radius of 7 km around Hangar 14. All of them are located less than 5 minutes walking distance from the city's public transportation network. The participants will have the chance to practice in prestigious places, used to receive big events.

The proximity of the sports facilities will make it easy to go and encourage colleagues involved in other disciplines between two meetings.

For the golf courses, 6 courses located at less than 20 km from Hangar 14 will allow to welcome all the golfers. Dedicated shuttle bus will drive you there.

COMING TO BORDEAUX

AN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Bordeaux airport offers more than 120 regular flights to over 100 destinations throughout Europe, plus numerous charter flights. It has direct connections to most European countries. In addition, Bordeaux Airport has daily connections with 9 of the 10 main European hubs: Amsterdam, Barcelona, Frankfurt, Istanbul, London (Gatwick), Madrid, Munich, Paris (Charles de Gaulle) and Rome. In addition, as of January 2023, the airport will be connected to the tramway network that will link downtown Bordeaux with the airport. Participants in the 2023 European Company Sport Games will be able to be picked up by the organization upon arrival at the airport and take advantage of free public transportation. A connection every 10 minutes!



BY TRAIN, IT'S VERY EASY

The Saint-Jean train station located in downtown Bordeaux has become the crossroads of southwestern France.

A total of 33 direct connections per day are possible with Paris, including 5 with Charles de Gaulle Airport.

Paris is thus only 2 hours away from the 2023 European Company Sport Games

GETTING AROUND BORDEAUX

GETTING AROUND BORDEAUX DURING THE EUROPEAN GAMES

Throughout the Games, participants will be able to take advantage of the entire Bordeaux Metropole public transportation network free of charge. With 4 tramway lines and 79 bus lines, participants will be able to make all their trips by public transport. This objective is important for our organization, which we want to be as eco-responsible as possible.

With this in mind, we have selected all the official accommodation as well as all the sports facilities. Except for the golf courses for which specific shuttles will be organized, all are located less than 5 minutes' walk from a tramway or bus stop. Hangar 14 is located near all tramway lines. For those who like to travel by bicycle, you can also take advantage of the 2,000 self-service bicycles in the network, spread out over the 184 stations in the city. Finally, the pass-transport offered to each participant will also allow you to travel on the "BatCub" which allows you to connect, by boat, the two banks of the city throughout the day.

DESTINATION BORDEAUX

IN 2007, BORDEAUX WAS LISTED AS A UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE
AND BECAME THE LARGEST URBAN ENSEMBLE SO DISTINGUISHED,
WITH SOME 1,810 HECTARES - NEARLY HALF THE AREA OF THE CITY!
AROUND FIFTEEN YEARS LATER, NEW BUILDINGS HAVE ENRICHED THE HERITAGE
AND COEXIST HARMONIOUSLY WITH THEIR HISTORIC NEIGHBORS.

AN EXCEPTIONAL HERITAGE

An open-air postcard! The city center, only accessible by tramway and bicycles, facilitates travel from one district to another with, always as a common thread, the Garonne River.

Each neighborhood has its own atmosphere! To the north, the Chartrons, a former stronghold of wine merchants, has become that of second-hand dealers, antique dealers, good restaurants and small independent shops. Then here is the vast Place des Quinconces. Behind its plane trees, the Grands Hommes district is a tribute to our thinkers, from Montaigne to Diderot: it is also called the "triangle" for its luxury stores, its mansions and the majestic Grand Théâtre, a masterpiece balance signed Victor Louis. Take a hook on the right and head for rue Sainte Catherine, the longest pedestrian and shopping street in Europe!

A stone's throw away, old Bordeaux: Saint-Pierre is a trendy and gourmet district with its good restaurants and terraces along the squares and pedestrian streets, to visit with your nose in the air to admire the Bordeaux mascarons, these ornaments carved in stone. On the quayside the Place de la Bourse and its majestic 18th century facades delight visitors who come to take THE souvenir photograph of Bordeaux.

The Miroir d'eau - largest mirror in the world - is facing the famous facade and amazes everyone with its beautiful mist show. After a quick jump you might be able to see three monuments that are

NATURE

With multiple gardens, parks, hillsides, forests and nature reserves, more than 200 km of bicycle paths, a navigable river, and a 160 km marked GR® trail. Bordeaux is a serene city that breathes and is the gateway to multiple adventures. Romantic rambles, sporty strolls, walks with the kids, picnics: there are many opportunities in the impressive diversity of Bordeaux's green spaces!

Along the quays, the Jardin des Lumières and the Parc aux Angéliques are real tree-lined corridors.

Near the city center: the Parc Bordelais (which houses the tallest tree in Bordeaux: 48 meters!) and the Jardin Public are unmissable. A few tramway stations away is the ecological reserve of the Barails, which includes the floral park, Bordeaux woods and the surrounding wetlands.



THE BIGGEST MIROIR D'EAU OF THE WORLD!

registered by the UNESCO: the Tour Pey Berland, a beautiful belvedere over the city, the Saint André cathedral and the Rohan palace that is the current city hall. To the south, the Cailhau door and the Grosse Cloche herald Saint-Michel, a cosmopolitan area that seduces visitors with the very much-loved Marché des Capucins and its junk stores. Unmissable stage at the 114 meters high Flèche Saint-Michel.

Then we discover the Place de la Victoire and its perpetual animation, its terraces and bars, which seduce the students. At the ends of the city, two new districts are emerging and redrawing the contours of the city: Bassins à Flot to the north, a former manufacturing center, and Euratlantique to the south, a comprehensive development operation that extends over 738 hectares around the train station and the municipalities of Bègles and Floirac. Head for the right bank, taking the stone bridge built by order of Napoleon I: green, like the Botanical Garden and the urban parks along the quays, it offers an incomparable view of the Port de la Lune and the listed facades. And there are surprises too: a blue lion by Xavier Veilhan, the Niel barracks, the Chaban-Delmas lift bridge inaugurated in 2013...



A BIKE PARADISE

Bordeaux is a flat city (except for the hillsides of the right bank), which is great for bicycle tourism. In 2019, the "Bicycle Cities Index" established by the German start-up Coya ranks Bordeaux as the 12th most bikeable city in the world. The conurbation has 291 km of bike paths and greenways. The Super Bike Routes offer suggestions for 1 to 5 hours rides to explore the city's heritage, nature, vineyards and river.

30 A SPORTING CITY

DESTINATION BORDEAUX

Bordeaux is a dynamic and obviously sporting city! With several major modern or historical sites dedicated to sport, Bordeaux and its suburbs offer a large choice of sporting activities.

The density and diversity of sports facilities, coupled with the know-how and experience of the voluntary sector, supported by the city, make Bordeaux the scene of numerous mass or high-level sporting gatherings every year. The Marathon of Bordeaux, the ATP tennis tournament and the International Jumping take place in Bordeaux every year.

Hosting the European Football Championships in 2016, the Rugby World Cup in 2023 and soccer meetings during the Paris Olympics in 2024 are proof of the region's sporting appeal. There is no doubt that the 24th European Company Sport Games will find their place alongside these events!


A DESTINATION COMMITTED TO SUSTAINABLE TOURISM

Thus, the Bordeaux Metropole Tourist and Convention Office intends to unite all tourism stakeholders in an eco-responsible approach. The year 2020 ended with more than encouraging news for the continuation of this approach: Bordeaux obtained a very good result in the Global Destination Sustainability Index, the main benchmarking program for destinations with sustainable strategies. The city overall score grew from 54% to 72% in one year.

Bordeaux now belongs to the most dynamic cities of the world.

This approach is made possible thanks to a solid base of places and actors already committed to sustainable tourism, whether on the social, environmental or ethical level.



A FESTIVE CITY

Having a drink on the terrace, listening to a live concert, dancing in a lively bar or club... Bordeaux nights are full of life and surprises.

Between nightclubs, bars and restaurants, the Bassins à Flot district is the place to be for party people. On the other side of the Garonne, the Chantiers de la Garonne offers a room and a sandy terrace with a breathtaking view of the river. On sunny days, its neighbor, the open-air cafe Chez Aliq, with its country atmosphere and its worldwide music program, is a must.

To enjoy a glass of Bordeaux (and elsewhere!) wine, head to one of the city's many wine bars.

The place offers a spectacular trip around the world, through the ages, in every culture!

TO THE NORTH, THE CHARENTE AND THE POITOU

1 hour 1/2 away: To the north of Bordeaux, the **Charente reveals its famous Cognac and Saintes houses.** Royan, city of art and history, combines modern Bauhaus architecture and typical villas of the 20s.

Off the coast, the Cordouan lighthouse can be visited at the pace of the tides.

Two hours away: the old port of La Rochelle, its three monumental towers and the arcades of its historic center. At the heart of the city, the Aquarium is one of the largest in Europe. Off the coast, nature escape between land and sea on the islands of Ré, Aix, Madame and Oléron.

Two and a half hours away: going to Poitiers, crossing the Marais Poitevin - largest marsh on the Atlantic coast - go to the **Vallée des Singes and Futuroscope.**

Halfway between Poitiers and Bordeaux is Angoulême, capital of comics and its facades which give pride of place to drawings and bubbles of all kinds!

TO THE EAST, THE LIMOUSIN, THE PÉRIGORD AND THE LOT-ET- GARONNE

Head east to Limoges where the Adrien Débouché National Museum presents machines and tools linked to the porcelain-making know-how that made the city famous. One and a half hours further east, Aubusson is home to the Cité Internationale de la Tapisserie. Going back down to the Dordogne valley, we come across breathtaking villages such as Collonges-la-Rouge or Rocamadour.

Then let's head to the Périgord, a land full of delights: proud castles, gourmet markets in Sarlat and Périgueux, Bergerac wines and the International Center of Cave Art which houses a full-scale replica of the original Lascaux cave. Going down to the Lot-et-Garonne, Villereal, with its 13th century royal bastide, is classified as the most beautiful village in France. You must pass through Agen, capital of the department. On your way back to Bordeaux you will find Marmande.

Every year in June, the city welcomes **more than 160,000 festival-goers for the Garorock festival.**

TO THE SOUTH, THE LANDES AND THE PAYS BASQUE

To the south of Bordeaux opens the Landes forest, largest expanse of maritime pine trees in Europe. Bordered by 100 km of magnificent ocean beaches suitable for surfing, it is above a whole land of gastronomy, good living and "férias" in Dax, Mont-de-Marsan, and in all the villages of the Chalosse. The unusual Marquèze Ecomuseum in Sabres takes you back to the 19th century's life of the Landes de Gascogne!

A total change of scene is guaranteed in the Basque Country, with its villages, its sense of celebration, Biarritz and its surf spots and Saint-Jean-de-Luz and its port. In the town of Sare, the little train of the Rhune, an authentic cogwheel train, takes visitors to the top of the Rhune, at an altitude of 905 meters. Exceptional panorama on all the Atlantic Coast and the Pyrenees chain. Further inland, the Béarn region, home of Henri IV, reveals Pau and its British charm, preserved valleys, kingdom of hiking and ski resorts.
