By organising the 24th European Company Sport Games, the French Federation for Company Sport (FFSE), alongside its European counterpart, the European Federation for Company Sport (EFCS), both chaired by Didier BESSEYRE, once again confirms that it is a major player in the vitality of sport in France.

Less than 500 days before the Summer Games, the first to be held in France for a century, it reinforces France's role as an organiser of major sporting events with international appeal. WELCOME TO BORDEAUX!

After months of preparation, the entire European Company Sport Games team is delighted to welcome you in Bordeaux. In this practical guide, you will find all the information you need to make your stay in Bordeaux a success.

As soon as you arrive in Bordeaux, you will find our team at the train station and the airport on Tuesday, 13th June, in the afternoon and all day on Wednesday, 14th June. They will guide you to public transports to come to the Hangar 14.

Thanks to your inscription, you benefit from a transport pass, which gives you an unlimited access to transports in Bordeaux. Make sure to download the TBM app and to activate your code, so that you can use your pass as soon as you arrive in Bordeaux (read more on page 10).

The registration of participants is carried out by the company/sports association representative. He will be given an accreditation for each participant in his group as well as a participant package and vouchers to collect prebooked meals. For bigger delegations, the packages can be heavy and difficult to carry.

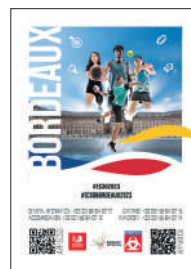

COME TO BORDEAUX

From the train station or the airport, the city centre of Bordeaux and the accreditation center of the European games are only 20 minutes away.

GO TO THE CITY CENTRE

ARRIVING BY PLANE AT THE BORDEAUX-MÉRIGNAC AIRPORT

After picking up your luggage, join us at the ECSG stand. STAFF members will wait for you at the terminus next to the tramway.




RENT A CAR

If you still want to rent a car, despite the organization of public transports, many companies have a stand at the airport. Renting is possible for anyone over 21 years old with a driver's license. Some companies require international insurance papers.

ARRIVING BY TRAIN AT THE TRAIN STATION BORDEAUX SAINT-JEAN

You arrive in the center of Bordeaux.

ARRIVING BY CAR

French highways are not free and the speed limits do not exceed 130 km/h.



GETTING AROUND IN BORDEAUX

For your travels before, during, and after the games, enjoy the public transports of Bordeaux metropole with the transports pass included in the registration fees.

You benefit from an unlimited access to all network lines (bus, tramway, boats). The accreditation cannot be used as a transports pass.

You have received by e-mail your electronic transports pass, **WHICH CAN BE USED FOR 7 DAYS AFTER IST FIRST USE IN BORDEAUX** (no matter on what day you arrive).

HOW TO GET STARTED?

This step requires an Internet connection and can be done before you arrive in France.

Download the TBM app for free

Create an account

Click on **M-TICKET**, then enter the activation code that we have sent you, then confirm.

Note: **THIS CODE IS UNIQUE AND CAN ONLY BE USED ON ONE SMARTPHONE.** Don't delete the app once you have used the code.

HOW TO USE THE PASS?



This step does not require an Internet connection.

Turn the Bluetooth mode and location on on your smartphone

Open the TBM app

Approach your smartphone to the fare box to validate each journey

THE PASS IS VALID FOR 7 DAYS AFTER IST FIRST USE.

But you need to validate it every time you go on a transport.

STAFF members will welcome you on Tuesday, 13th June, in the afternoon, and on Wednesday, 14th June, all day, at the airport and at the train station. They can help you activate your transport pass and guide you to the Hangar 14, where you can get your accreditations.

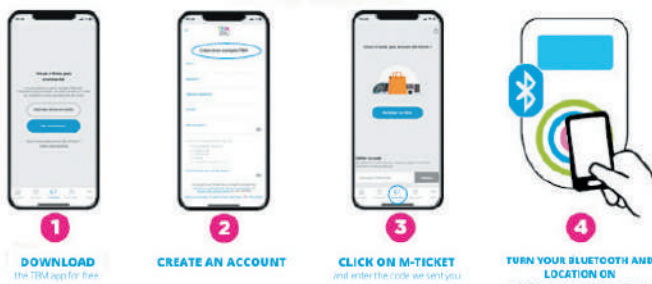

YOUR PASS ON YOUR SMARTPHONE



If you get asked to show your pass, please show the QR code available on the app. Make sure that your phone is charged enough to be able to show your pass anytime. Your pass allows you to use tram, bus, flat's (bicyc) and bicycles. You have to validate your journey everytime you go in, even when changing lines.

TRAVEL BY NIGHT WITH TBNIGHT

Go back to your hotel with bus lines from TBNight on Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

ECO-FRIENDLY EVENT

The Organizing Committee of the 24th European Company Sport Games is doing its utmost to offer an eco-friendlier event. This great celebration of company sport has a duty to set an example: to sustainably shape the behavior and habits of spectators, athletes and partners, to contribute to the evolution of social norms and to reduce the environmental footprint of participants.

The commitment of the French Federation for Company Sport (FFSE) to sustainable development is demonstrated during the event by concrete actions, which include :

All participants will receive a water bottle in their package. No plastic water bottles will be distributed and deposit ecocups will also be available. Each sports venue is set up so that you can fill up your water bottle. The running water in Bordeaux is of very good quality.

Waste separation is offered on all sports facilities in order to upgrade the recycling of the waste produced. Please refer to the appropriate signs at Hangar 14 and at the sports facilities.

The sports competitions, festive events and hotels are adapted to the public transport network. With the transport pass, each participant can move around the city of Bordeaux without limits. Prefer public transport or «soft» transport to private vehicles in order to organise an event 100% by public transport.



Together with the organising committees of the 2023 Rugby World Cup and the 2024 Paris Olympic and Paralympic Games, the FFSE and the EFCS are partners in the European project supported by the European Commission and led by the European Association of Sport Employers (EASE), which aims to establish a social charter for sporting events. The ECSG organising committee is also a signatory to the Ministry of Sport for the Olympic and Paralympic Games Charter.

For each participant who has booked their lunch and/or dinner, the delegation representative will receive vouchers together with the accreditations to pick up their meals at the sports facilities and Hangar 14.

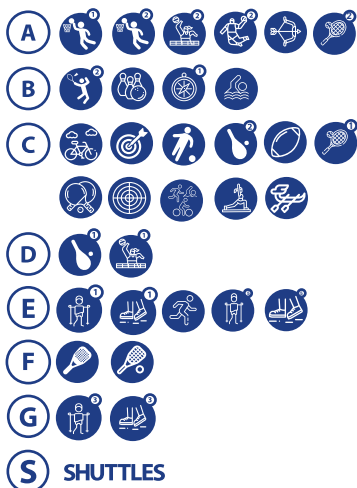

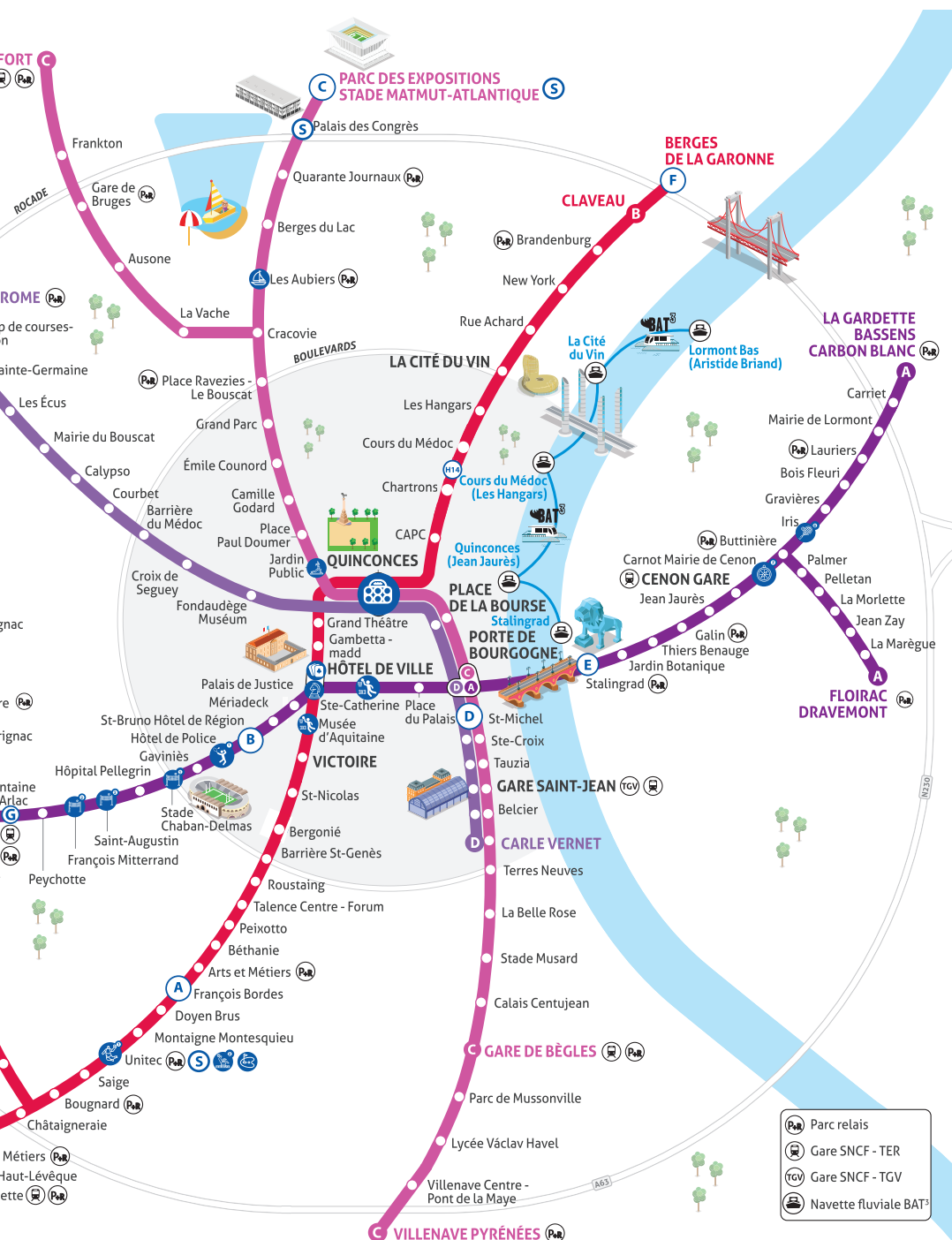
